## Primary Care

- Physician and Nurse Practitioner services
- Nursing services – include health assessments; immunizations; reproductive health, including PAPs & STI

screening; wound care; advanced foot care; health education/promotion; assessment support for virtual physician appointments.



## Mental Health

Mental health services support all mental wellness needs including addictions, substance use and misuse, grief and loss, trauma and access to specialized psychiatric services.



## Traditional Wellness

Our Wellness Coordinator arranges for healers to provide one-on-one healing sessions as well as Elders, Knowledge Keepers and Language

Speakers to provide a variety of wellness activities, both at the Healing House and on the land. (This includes: sewing ribbon skirts/shirts/drum bags, beading, flint napping, drum making, medicine picking and making, language classes and more.)



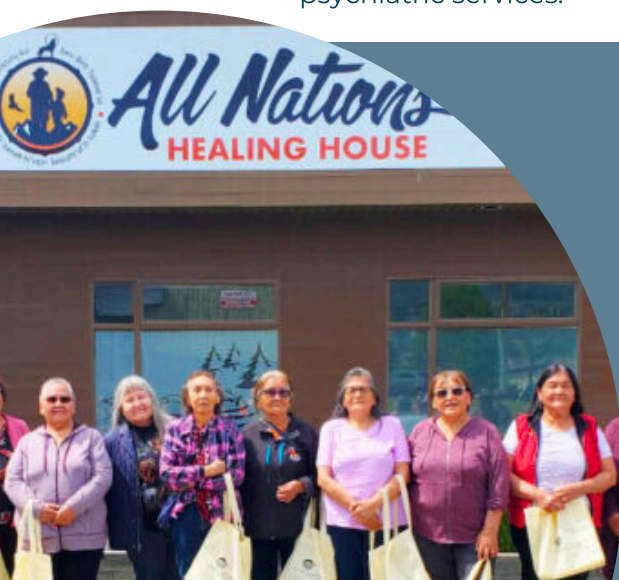
## Wrap Around Services
